

PRIVACY POLICY

Introduction

- **Gorle Global Group** ("We") is committed to safeguarding the privacy of visitors' information on our website. This Privacy Policy ("Policy") explains what personal data we collect from you, how we collect it, and how we use, store, disclose, or otherwise process your personal data when you use our website or any other means through which we handle your data.
- This Policy applies to the Gorle Global Group website, which may contain links to third-party websites with differing privacy policies. If you provide data to any of those websites, your data is governed by their privacy policies.
- By accessing or using our website, you confirm that you have read, understood, and agreed to the privacy practices and policies outlined in this Policy and agree to be bound by its terms.
- You consent to our collection, storage, and processing of your information in accordance with this Policy.
- If you do not agree with any terms of this Policy, please do not use our website or services. This Policy is subject to change at any time without notice. Please review it periodically to stay informed of any updates.

This Privacy Policy is intended to describe what we are doing with your Personal Data, how we protect it, and what privacy rights you may have under applicable data protection laws.

This privacy policy ("Privacy Policy") is published in compliance with inter alia: Section 43A of the Information Technology Act, 2000 ("IT Act"); Regulation 4 of the Information Technology (Reasonable Security Practices and Procedures and Sensitive Personal Information) Rules, 2011 ("SPDI Rules"); and Regulation 3(1) of the Information Technology (Intermediary Guidelines and Digital Media Ethics Code) Rules, 2021 ("Intermediaries Guidelines") and The Digital Personal Data Protection Act, 2023

Collecting Personal Information

- We may collect, store, and use the following types of personal information:
- Information about your computer and your visits to and use of this website (including your IP address, geographical location, browser type and version, operating system, referral source, length of visit, page views, and website navigation paths);
- Information that you provide to us when registering on our website, including but not limited to your name, email address, and mobile number;
- Information provided for subscribing to our email notifications and/or newsletters (including your name and email address);
- Information provided during the use of services on our website or generated through your use of those services (including the timing, frequency, and pattern of service use);
- Information contained in or relating to any communications sent to us via enquiry forms or otherwise

on our website (including the content and metadata of the communication);

- Any other personal information that you choose to provide.
- Before disclosing another person's personal information, you must obtain their consent to both the disclosure and processing of that information in accordance with this Policy.

Access, Correction, and Deletion

- We take reasonable precautions to ensure that the personal information we collect, use, and disclose is accurate, complete, and up-to-date. However, the accuracy of your information depends largely on what you provide.
- We recommend that you keep us updated with changes to your personal information, such as your name, mobile number, or address, and inform us of any errors.
- We reserve the right to charge a fee for searching for and providing access to your information.

However, you acknowledge that certain data cannot be corrected or deleted if required under applicable law, law enforcement requests, or judicial proceedings, and will continue to be maintained as per legal mandates.

Using Your Personal Information

- If you submit personal information for publication on our website, we will publish and otherwise use that information in accordance with the license you grant us.

Disclosing Personal Information

- We may disclose your personal information to:
- Any of our employees, officers, advisers, agents, or service providers, as reasonably necessary for the purposes set out in this Policy;

- Service providers who assist in protecting and securing our systems and provide services requiring the processing of personal data, such as hosting or data profiling;
- Any member of our group of companies (including affiliates and subsidiaries) as reasonably necessary for the purposes set out in this Policy;
- Government and regulatory authorities, agencies, and other organizations, as required or authorized by law;
- Any person where we reasonably believe that disclosure is required to comply with a legal obligation or to protect the rights, property, or safety of Gorle Global Group, our customers, or others.
- Except as provided in this Policy, we will not provide your personal information to third parties.

International Data Transfers

- Information we collect may be stored, processed, and transferred between any of the countries in which we operate to enable us to use the information in accordance with this Policy.
- Personal information that you publish on our website or submit for publication may be available worldwide via the internet. We cannot prevent the use or misuse of such information by others.
- You expressly agree to the transfers of personal information described in this section.

Retaining Personal Information

- This section outlines our data retention policies and procedures, designed to help us comply with our legal obligations regarding the retention and deletion of personal information.
- Personal information processed for any purpose shall not be kept longer than is necessary for that purpose.
- Notwithstanding the above, we may retain documents (including electronic documents) containing personal data:
 - To the extent required by law;
 - If we believe the documents may be relevant to any ongoing or prospective legal proceedings;
 - To establish, exercise, or defend our legal rights (including providing information to others for fraud prevention and reducing credit risk).
- Even if we delete your data, it may persist on backup or archival media for audit, legal, tax, or regulatory purposes.

Security of Your Personal Information

- We will take reasonable technical and organizational precautions to prevent the loss, misuse, or alteration of your personal information.
- Our technical and organizational measures include protocols for handling suspected data breaches. If you suspect any misuse, loss, or unauthorized access to your data, please contact us immediately.
- We will store all personal information you provide on our secure servers, which are protected by passwords and firewalls.

- You acknowledge that the transmission of information over the internet is inherently insecure, and we cannot guarantee the security of data sent over the internet.
- We are not responsible for compliance issues beyond our control, including force majeure events.
